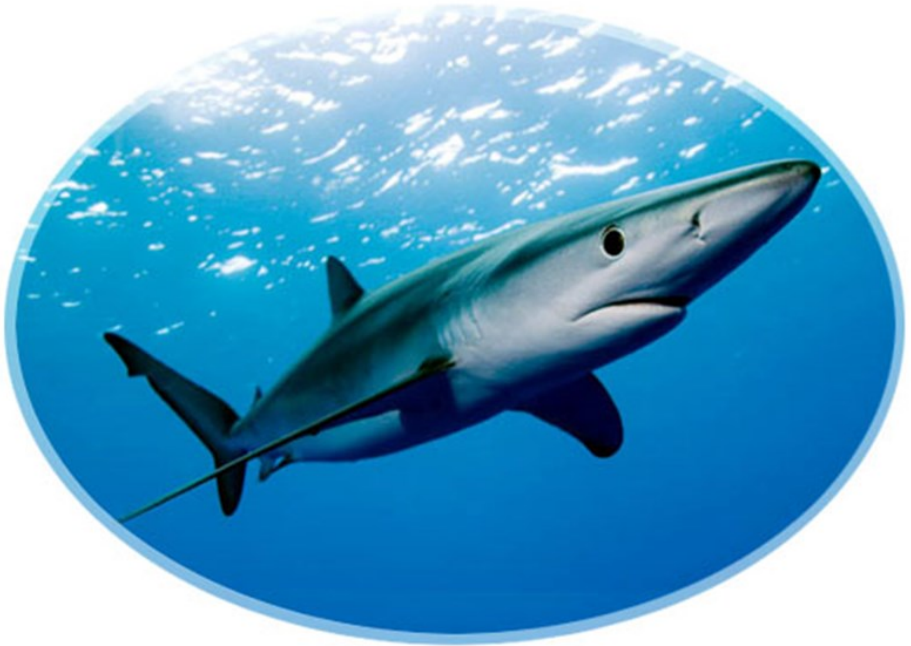


Frank's Journey

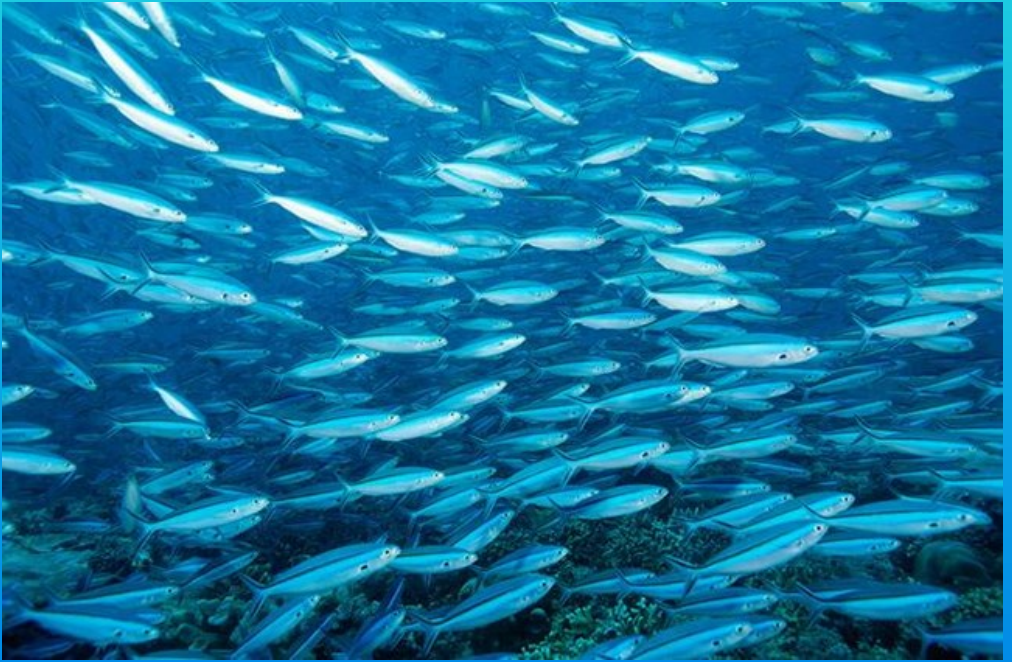
Once upon a time,

but they did not satisfy his hunger



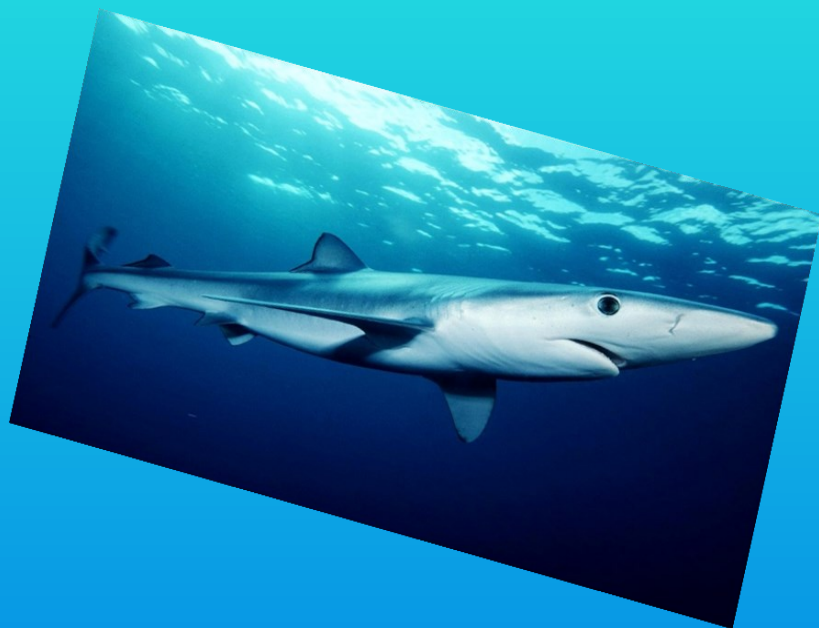
After a long time swimming he came

Even as Frank said this he knew it would be a tough promise to keep!

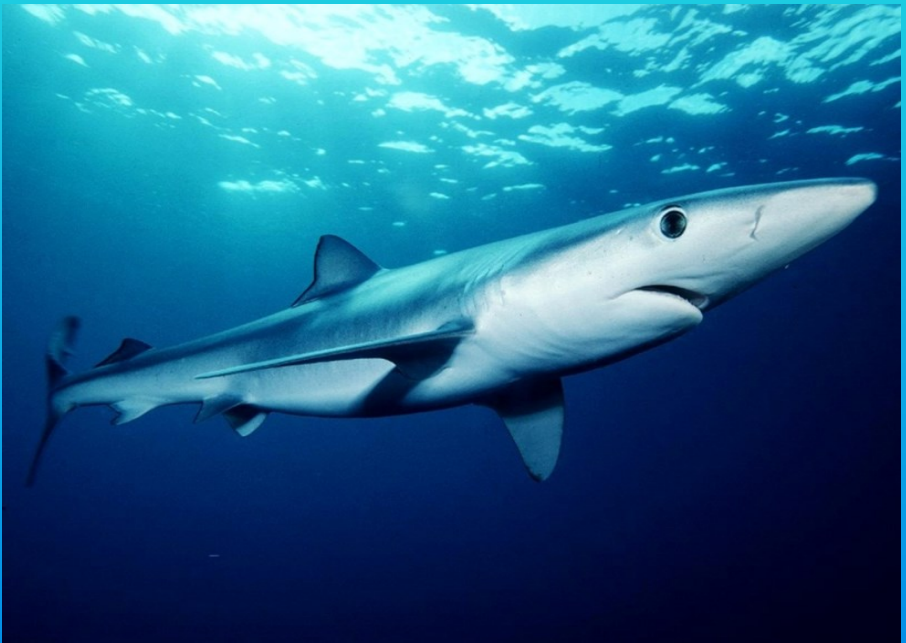
The squid felt badly for Frank.
